## **NYS DOH Updates:**

- DOH hosted a Pediatric Health Home webinar on 4/7/16 and provided a lot of new information, if you would like to see a full list of new updates please refer to the following link: April 7, 2016 Health Home Serving Children: Readiness and Implementation Updates
  - o The State Plan Amendment (SPA) APPROVED by CMS
  - Many items were approved in the new SPA to highlight a few:
    - Use of the modified CANS-NY Assessment
    - Modifications to Health Home eligibility criteria for children: Serious Emotional Disturbances (SED) (Health Home Definition) and Complex Trauma (CMA/SAMHSA definition) as single qualifying conditions for Health Home eligibility
    - The state agreed to shift the effective date for enrollment from September 1, 2016 to
      October 1, 2016 to coincide with the CMS SPA approval period
- CANS-NY
  - o As of April, 29 2016 the CANS-NY training is ready for use

- MAPP Phase II Training
  - o Go Live date: September 2016
  - DOH is working with their MAPP training consultants to plan an in-person training for Lead Children's Health Home Staff.
